1. Subscriptions

Subscriptions are for a calendar year (January-December) and the Journals are accessed by the institution's IP address.

1. Copyright

Copyright of the Journals is owned by the Publisher except as noted otherwise on individual articles.

2. License

i)Swets & Zeitlinger Publishers hereby grants the Subscriber and its Authorized Users the right to:

Permit Authorized Users to search, view and browse the licensed online journals in the university/corporate network;

permit Authorized Users to print or download excerpts of reasonable quantity or single copies of individual articles (not an entire issue of a journal);

permit Authorized Users to obtain remote access to the online journals through secure access procedures established by the Subscriber.

- (ii) **Authorized Users.** Includes persons, employees, faculty, staff and students officially affiliated with the Subscriber and who are authorized clients of the Subscriber's library facilities. Authorized users includes persons affiliated with remote sites or campuses of Subscriber that are administered from Subscriber's site or campus, but not persons affiliated with remote sites or campuses with separate administrative staffs. For companies and governmental institutions, Authorized Users means scientific and support staff employed by the Subscriber.
- (iii)Consortium Access. This Agreement does NOT permit use of the Journals among a regional or other type of consortium
- (iv) **Library Access.** If the Subscriber provides to the public access to its general library they may be granted the rights to the online journals for research purposes providing they access the materials from a workstation located in the library. This Agreement does not permit remote access by members of the public.
- (v) **Course packs.** The Subscriber may include copies of items- from the online journals in anthologies (course packs) in print or digital form for sale or distribution to the Authorized Users for their use in classroom instruction, providing the Publisher is notified and any requested fee is paid. Digital course packs are to be deleted by the Subscriber at the end of the semester.
- (vi)**Interlibrary Lending.** Institutions may use hard copies derived directly or indirectly from the electronic edition of the publication for the purpose of inter-library loan with the same limitations that apply to paper copies for that purpose made from the print edition of the journals. Specifically, copies

must be made in compliance with current copyright laws and with guidelines developed by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works (CONTU Guidelines).

(vii) **Usage Restrictions.** No material from the online journals may be substantially or systematically reproduced, re-engineered, redistributed, resold or sub-licensed in any way; no part of the Journals may be supplied or distributed to an unauthorized user.

(viii)**Perpetual Access.** If the subscription is terminated the Subscriber will continue to have access to the material which was subscribed to for the duration of the Agreement (unless terminated because of a breach of Agreement) if requested by the Subscriber and providing the Subscriber continues to observe its obligations with respect to security and the restrictions on usage.

3. Security

The Subscriber is solely responsible for any use of the Subscriber's IP addresses, or User-IDs and passwords, whether or not authorized, to access the Journals. The Subscriber recognizes that they are obligated to ensure that the online journals are accessed by Authorized Users only and that the Publisher may terminate or revoke this Agreement should routine violations occur. The Subscriber shall make reasonable efforts to monitor compliance and to rectify misuse.

4. Warranty

The Publisher has made and will make reasonable efforts to ensure that the Journals are complete and accurate. The Publisher does not warrant that the information in the Journals is completely free from error and does not assume, and expressly disclaims any liability to any person for any loss or damage caused by errors or omission in the Journals. Both parties expressly exclude any liability for breach of any implied or express warranty as to merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose

5. Termination

Unless terminated because of breach of Agreement, this license shall be valid for the duration of the subscription to the Journals unless the Publisher introduces a revised Licence Agreement.

6. Force Majeure

The Publisher's failure to perform any term or condition of this Agreement as a result of conditions beyond its control such as, but not limited to, war, strikes, fires, floods, governmental restrictions, power failures, or damage or destruction of any network facilities or servers, shall not be deemed a breach of this Agreement.
